

Constance Backhouse – notice biographique

Professor Constance Backhouse is a member of the Faculty of Law at the University of Ottawa. She has published a number of prize winning books: *Petticoats and Prejudice: Women and Law in Nineteenth-Century Canada*; *Challenging Times: The Women's Movement in Canada and the United States*; *Colour-Coded: A Legal History of Racism in Canada, 1900-1950*; *The Heiress vs the Establishment: Mrs. Campbell's Campaign for Legal Justice*; *Carnal Crimes: Sexual Assault Law in Canada, 1900-1975*. Her latest book, *Claire L'Heureux-Dubé: A Life*, was just released. She was made a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada in 2004 and named to the Order of Canada in 2008.
